PROGRAMME:

Organiser: The Holland Cup is organised by FC Almere, AS'80, ASC Waterwijk and Sporting Almere with the active support of the city of Almere.

Sports Grounds: The Tournament is played at four modern sports parks, all situated around the centre of Almere. The sports park has five to eight fields and a beautiful clubhouse with a big canteen and terrace. and plenty of parking facilities.
