



R&T Football Tours Good Behaviour Charter

We want you to enjoy every second of your tournament weekend both on and off the pitch. Our Good Behaviour Charter represents sensible rules of conduct, which will help ensure the safety and enjoyment of your own party, and other holidaymakers.

Please always be on your best behaviour – you are representing your teams and always on show.

- Please be considerate of other guests and keep the noise down - especially at night.
- Do not allow children in the party to wander around the holiday park unsupervised. This is particularly important in the evenings – there is room for everyone to have a great time.
- Your safety is our priority. Please ensure that there is a responsible adult available to supervise your party at all times.
- Those wanting to perfect your ball skills - please do not allow children to play ball games around the accommodation – it is important you ensure children play football in a suitable area of the holiday park.
- In the event of any disturbance made by members of your group, the holiday park management reserves the right to demand compensation for other guests and may ask for your removal from the premises.
- Unreasonable and or offensive behaviour, fighting, or acts of malicious damage by any individual in the group will not be tolerated under any circumstances and can result in the entire party being asked to leave the holiday park without entitlement to refund.
- In the event of damage to property or injury, the holiday park management will have the right to demand appropriate compensation from the entire group.

REMEMBER - In the United Kingdom it is illegal for children under the age of 18 to purchase and/or consume alcohol.

1. Do not allow children who are below the legal age for the consumption of alcohol to purchase alcohol for their consumption or to consume alcohol, which has been purchased by an adult.
2. Do not allow adults to purchase alcohol on behalf of a child or supply them with alcohol.
3. Any group whose children are discovered attempting to purchase or consume alcohol may be asked to leave the site.
4. Any adult who purchases alcohol for a child WILL be asked to leave the site.
5. Alcohol abuse is unacceptable, and could result in the removal of persons, or your whole party from the site.
6. Please do not allow **anyone** to consume alcohol at pitchside during the tournament. Any persons found doing so will be asked to leave the grounds.

A lot of hard work and organisation across all parties has gone into making this weekend the best. We want you to have a fantastic time and to do your bit by simply complying with the above.
