Sports Grounds: The Bruges Open event is held at KSK Steenbrugge with excellent facilities and 4 immaculate pitches near the bustling town of Bruges. The sports ground offers excellent pitches, plus canteen/clubhouse and changing rooms.

The matches will be played according to the rules of the Belgian Football Association. Dispensation is given to British teams up to 4 months over-age - from 1st September of the previous year. The number of players with this dispensation is unlimited per match.

Friday Evening: Free time - see tourist information for some great tips.

Saturday Morning: Start of the match programme. The matches will be played at KSK Steenbrugge sports grounds near Brugge Centre. The matches will be officiated by referees from the Belgium Football Association.

Sunday Daytime: Continuation of the match programme. Qualification matches and finals followed by prize-giving ceremony at the sports parks.
