# PROGRAMME:

Organiser: The Copa Castell is a joint project of CF Tordera, the local Euro-Sportring team and the Catalan Football Association. They guarantee the professional organisation of the tournament.

Sports Grounds: The Copa Jordi takes place at a large sports park just outside the seaside resort of Blanes. The grounds feature 10 grass pitches, various other facilities (changing rooms, parking, first aid), and a café bar with a spacious shaded terrace. The grounds come complete with terraces, giving supporters a good view of the fields. Depending on the number of participating teams, a second venue of organiser CF Tordera will be used just a few minutes from the Soccerland Catalunya sports park. During tournament days, there is a multilingual Euro-Sportring desk, where team leaders can go for information and bookings.

Minimum of 5 matches are played with a duration of 2 x 15 minutes each way.

HOW THE PROGRAMME RUNS:

Friday 3rd April:

Morning: All participants line up at the stadium in Pineda de Mar, followed by a Parade through the town to the stadium

Afterwards: Atmospheric opening ceremony in the stadium. Ceremony with all teams, national anthems. Followed by an opening match and group matches according to tournament schedule

Evening: Excursions

Saturday morning: Group matches according to tournament schedule

During the day: Excursions

Evening: Summary – invitation from KOMM MIT. For one representative per participating team as a thank you for their commitment to youth work, snack according to national custom with review of the event and exchange of host gifts with a municipal representative.

Sunday morning: Start of quarter-finals and semi-finals

Afternoon: Start of finals

Evening: Grand award ceremony with trophy presentation and closing fireworks display.
