PROGRAMME:

Organiser: VV Maastricht West is an amateur football club in the Dutch city of Maastricht. The club was formed on 1 July 2021 after a merger between RKVV/L/Polaris and VV SCM. In the 2020/21 season, the clubs already played under the composite name SSA West United. The club plays its matches at Sportpark West, part of the Van de Vennepark, which was also previously the home base of RKVV/L/Polaris.

Sports Grounds: The Maastricht Trophy is played at several locations in the western part of Maastricht, close to the Belgian border. The RKASV facilities comprise 3 lit pitches, a clubhouse and 26 changing rooms. The facilities are located close to the new Geusselt complex, situated behind the swimming pool. The locations are around 15-20 minutes away from the centre of Maastricht.

Minimum of 5 matches are played with a duration of 2 x 15 minutes each way.

Friday Arrival: Welcome and information in the hotel in Maastricht.

Saturday Morning: Start of the match programme. The matches will be played at two sports parks in the west of Maastricht. The matches will be officiated by referees from the Royal Dutch Football Association (KNVB).

Sunday Daytime: Continuation of the match programme. Qualification matches and finals followed by prize-giving ceremony at the sports parks, followed by a UEFA Respect ceremony.

Sunday Afternoon: UEFA Respect ceremony is held where every participant receives a medal on the podium.
