PROGRAMME

Organiser: The Hanze Trophy is a joint project of the Zwolle clubs, SVI and ZAC. The clubs have a collective membership of a few thousand, and more than 100 teams in all categories.

Sports Grounds: The Hanze Trophy takes place at two sports grounds on the southern side of Zwolle, four kilometres from the historic city centre. The sports grounds are situated a few minutes apart by car and feature more than 10 pitches in total. You'll find a spacious clubhouse at each location and a wide range of other facilities, including a large canteen with a terrace, as well as tournament kiosks and a grill.

Minimum of 6 matches are played with a duration of 2 x 15 minutes each way.

HOW THE PROGRAMME RUNS:

Friday Arrival: Welcome and information in the hotel in Zwolle.

Friday Evening: Free time - see tourist information for some great tips.

Saturday Morning: Start of the match programme. The matches will be played at four large sports parks around Zwolle. The matches will be officiated by referees from the Royal Dutch Football Association (KNVB).

Sunday Daytime: Continuation of the match programme. Qualification matches and finals followed by prize-giving ceremony at the sports parks, followed by a UEFA Respect ceremony.

Sunday Afternoon: UEFA Respect ceremony is held where every participant receives a medal on the podium.
